Wetland Vision map for the types of pond action needed on the ground for England






This map illustrates a range of local conditions and scenarios in which pond creation could be beneficial in a 50-year context. It is desirable to create ponds in: i) close proximity to other ponds ii) close proximity to BAP species associated with ponds iii) close to the river channel iv) contributing to the mosaic of existing wetlands. This map is indicative of the places in which ponds will need to be established within a 50- year context and is based on a buffering of features. More accurate local datasets can illustrate priority areas more effectively.
